Travel:

The Indianapolis International Airport is approximately 20 minutes from the hotel. The hotel is 1 mile from Beech Grove High School. Transportation options to the hotel from the airport are either a rental car or taxi. There is not an airport shuttle from the hotel. While we cannot guarantee a ride, you can email and we could possibly make arrangements with the Beech Grove personnel staffing the CI to be picked up at the airport and dropped off at the hotel. Daily transportation will need to be arranged with other participants if you are not driving.

Course description:

YDAE 64000 is a graduate course in technical agriculture knowledge for secondary agricultural science and business teachers. The emphasis in this course is on agricultural technologies and their theoretical and pragmatic applications for classroom teachers based on contemporary trends and information, and the needs of the teachers. The principles and procedures of curriculum construction will be applied to courses of study currently in agricultural science and business.

YDAE 64000 is a course in emerging research and information about agricultural technologies from the disciplines housed in Purdue's College of Agriculture. It is intended to provide information and practice on integrating agricultural technology into the high school curriculum. Although the course is designed for agricultural science and business teachers, others may take the course with permission of the instructor.
